Dorothy Nell Wylie, 83, of Blythewood, died Thursday, July 22, 2021, in Lexington Medical Center after a long illness. She was born in Columbia, February 18, 1938, a daughter of the late Mamie Elmore Mathis and Furman Marion Mathis.

Mrs. Wylie was a member of Denny Terrace Baptist Church. She was a talented cook, winning many ribbons at the South Carolina State Fair. When she did find the time to sit down, she loved to embroider items such as tablecloths and pillow cases for her friends and family.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Robert Wilson Wylie and her son, Robert "Bobby" Wilson Wylie, Jr.; sisters: Mary Brewer, Sally Moak, Betty Moak, and Virginia Warren; and brothers: Eldridge Mathis and Douglas Mathis. 
